As referenced in the Equalization Procedures Guide, Section 1.3 – Equalization Steering Committee, the Equalization Steering Committee is coordinating a vote to elect new representatives to serve on the Committee. A nomination form was distributed to industry on March 27, 2026.

For the current term, the Committee requires one new representative from the **Shipper/Marketer** category to maintain balanced representation across members representing condensate, medium and light crude producers, heavy crude producers, refiners, and marketers, all of whom are also Shippers.

No vote is required for the Shipper/Refiner and Shipper/Producer categories. One position remains open for Condensate, Medium and Light Crude Producers, and one position remains open for Heavy Producers.
